The Court, having considered Plaintiffs' motion, requesting among other things, an order requiring imaging of Defendant's devices and accounts, and finding good cause therefor, HEREBY ORDERS THAT:

Plaintiffs' request for an order requiring imaging of Defendant's devices and accounts is GRANTED.

Plaintiffs and Defendant will, respectively, provide the Court with the names of three qualified forensic experts within two weeks of the date of this order.

From those lists, the Court shall select and appoint a neutral forensic expert ("Expert").

Defendant shall make available to the Expert any computers, mobile phones, hard drives, or other electronic storage devices (collectively, "Devices") in his possession, custody, or control used in connection with Nitro TV, as well as any email accounts, social media accounts, and messengering applications (e.g., Telegram) (collectively, "Accounts") Defendant used in connection with Nitro TV.

Defendant shall prepare a sworn declaration attesting that the Devices and Accounts he provided to the Expert are all the Devices and Accounts in his possession, custody, or control that he, or anyone working with him or at his direction (such as the individuals identified in Plaintiffs' motion), used in connection with Nitro TV.

The Expert will take forensic, mirror images all such Devices and Accounts as well as reconstruct, if possible, any deleted data on such Devices and Accounts.

The Expert will prepare an index of the ESI in the mirror images. The index shall include, for any files that were previously deleted and since-reconstructed, the title of the file and the date of deletion.

The Expert will provide a copy of the index to both parties and a copy of the forensic, mirror images to Defendant. The Expert shall retain the original forensic, mirror images.

1	The parties will meet and confer about terms for Defendant to run against the
2	ESI from the mirror images.
3	Defendant's counsel will then review the ESI for responsiveness and
4	privilege, and produce all responsive materials, as well as a privilege log for any
5	materials withheld on privilege grounds.
6	The cost of imaging will be borne by Defendant.
