[PROPOSED] JUDGMENT

TO ALL PARTIES AND TO THEIR ATTORNEY(S) OF RECORD HEREIN:

Plaintiff Triller Fight Club II LLC’s (“Fight Club” or “Plaintiff”) brought the present action against Defendants Arvin de la Santos (“Santos”), Your Extra (“Your Extra” and, together with Santos, “Defendants”), and Does 1-10.

Plaintiff’s Motion for Summary Judgment came on for hearing before this Court on May 16, 2022. After considering the moving and opposing papers and all supporting evidence, arguments of counsel, and all other matters presented to the Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. Judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendants, with prejudice, on each of the following grounds:
 - a. Defendants directly infringed on Plaintiff’s copyright.
 - b. Defendants vicariously infringed on Plaintiff’s copyright.
 - c. Defendants violated the Communications Act.
2. Plaintiff is entitled to statutory damages in the amount of \$50,000 from Defendants, jointly and severally, pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504(a)-(c).
3. Plaintiff is entitled to statutory damages in the amount of \$10,000 from Defendants, jointly and severally, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 605.
4. Plaintiff is entitled to recover from Defendants reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs in connection with this action pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 505 and 47 U.S.C. § 605.
