PLAINTIFFS' NOTICE OF DISMISSAL OF DEFENDANT VEEPN CORP. WITH PREJUDICE

Pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(i) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and subject to the terms of a confidential settlement between Defendant VeePN Corp. and Plaintiffs Voltage Holdings, LLC; Voltage Pictures, LLC; After II Movie, LLC; Venice PI, LLC; Wonder One, LLC; Screen Media Ventures, LLC; American Cinema International, Inc.; American Cinema Inspires, Inc.; and 42 Ventures, LLC (collectively "Plaintiffs"), Plaintiffs hereby dismiss all claims against Defendant VeePN Corp. with prejudice.

Pursuant to the confidential settlement agreement, Plaintiffs have requested, and Defendant VeePN Corp. has agreed to use commercially reasonable efforts to block BitTorrent traffic on its servers in the United States to prevent customers of its VPN service from using the BitTorrent protocol to download and/or share content from servers in the United States under Defendant's control, and to use commercially reasonable efforts to block access from servers in the United States under Defendant's control to the certain notorious piracy websites located outside of the United States. *See* Aff. of Rozum at ¶3.

In accordance with this notice, Plaintiffs request that the temporary restraining order ("TRO") [Doc. #16] against Defendant VeePN Corp. be dissolved, the hearing scheduled for Aug. 4, 2022 be vacated and the \$500 bond for the TRO be returned to Plaintiffs' counsel.

It should be noted that this filing only terminates Defendant VeePN Corp. and does not terminate the matter as claims remain against Defendants DOES 1-100.
